Janitorial Maintenance Firms

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey

will set aside almost 20 multi-year cleaning contracts over the next five years to be bid by agency-certified janitorial maintenance small business enterprises. To optimize this program, we want to increase the number of certified SBEs in the janitorial maintenance field.

Janitorial Maintenance Small Business Enterprise Program

The Janitorial Maintenance Small Business Enterprise Program (JMSBE) provides Port Authority-certified JMSBEs the opportunity to compete with companies of similar size and capacity. Once certified as an SBE, vendors must participate in a prequalification process to determine the firm's eligibility to bid or submit proposals for future cleaning contracts at Port Authority facilities.

Contract Opportunities

Over the next five years, the Port Authority's Procurement Department will award nearly 20 contracts ranging from \$35,000 to \$5.5 million a year to firms certified and prequalified as JMSBEs.

What You Can Do

- If your firm meets the Port Authority's SBE eligibility requirements, apply for certification today. Once certified, your company will have access to exciting Port Authority contract opportunities, as well as a full complement of business assistance programs.
- If you know of an eligible company, help them out by passing along this flyer.

It's A Two-Step Process To Participate

1 GET JMSBE CERTIFIED

To be eligible firms at a minimum:

- Must not exceed the average annualized gross revenue of \$16.5 million a year for the last three (3) fiscal years.
- Must have been in operation for a minimum of three years.
- Must have their principal operations in either New York or New Jersey.

2 GET PREQUALIFIED

- Must be prequalified in one of four dollar categories.
- Eligibility is determined based on your response to a *Request for Prequalification – General Cleaning Services*.
